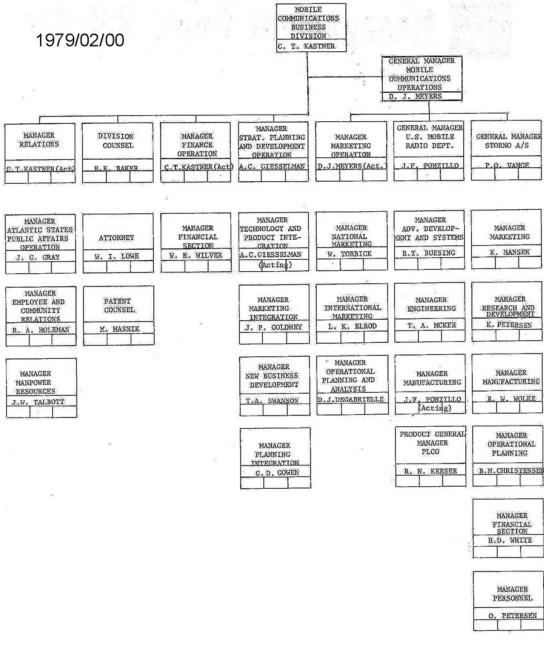

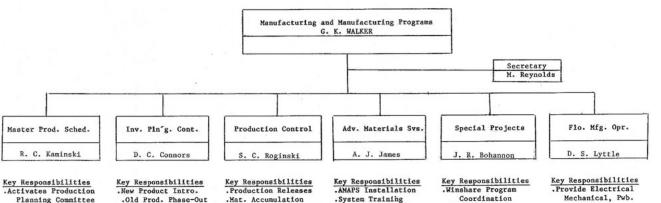

He graduated from the University of Massachusetts with a Bachelor's Degree in Marketing and finished with an MBA.

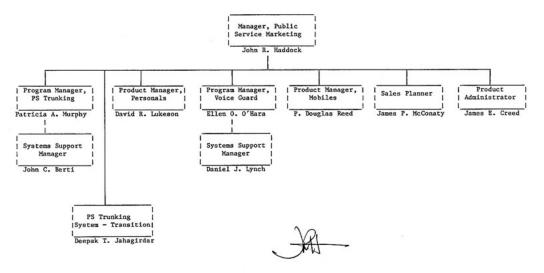
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Pat Murphy will also be acting for the next 60 days as Product Manager - Personals/Mobiles - B/I.
